**38th Annual Meeting of the
Society for Invertebrate Pathology
University of Alaska, Anchorage
August 7-11, 2005**

Arrangements for the 38th Annual Meeting of the Society for Invertebrate Pathology to be held in Anchorage, Alaska, are progressing well. Members will want to plan some extra time before, during, or after the meeting to enjoy the multitude of things to see and do in the Anchorage area or around other parts of Alaska. The scientific program and housing will be on the campus of the University of Alaska, Anchorage (UAA) (University web site: <http://www.uaa.alaska.edu/>); alternative housing at nearby hotels is also available.

The Program and Abstracts will be provided in attendees' registration packets, and SIP members and attendees will be able to download them from the SIP website in late July. For previous instructions, details, and information regarding the 2005 meeting, refer to the February 2005 Newsletter or the meeting website referenced above. Updates will be posted to the web site as the summer progresses. *New information will be highlighted in red.*

Scientific Program. The 38th Annual Meeting will begin with afternoon registration and an evening welcome mixer on Sunday, August 7, 2005 from 6-9 pm, followed

by a full scientific program Monday through Thursday. The scientific program will open Monday morning with the Founder's Lecture and Plenary Session, followed by afternoon symposia and contributed papers. The excursion and BBQ will be on Tuesday afternoon, and the meeting will close with the banquet on Thursday evening. Symposia and contributed paper sessions will be conducted throughout the meeting except Tuesday afternoon. Posters will be set up on Monday and may stay up until Thursday morning. The Division business meetings are slated for the evenings of Monday and Wednesday, to be followed by division workshops. The student workshop will be held Wednesday during lunchtime. The Society's business meeting will be held late morning on Wednesday.

Registration/Abstract submission. The deadline for submission of abstracts and for regular paid registration has passed, but late registration at a slightly higher fee (except for students) will be accepted until **August 1, 2005**. After August 1, walk-in registration will be accepted according to the fee schedule posted on the meeting web site and in the February 2005 Newsletter.

Please note that walk-in registration (after August 1) is more expensive for all participants.
